The Dental Health Clinic is sponsored by the Centennial Baptist Association and the Georgia Baptist Mission Board. Over the years, we have been able to serve over 550 people with dental needs. Our next dental clinic will be held March 7-9, 2024 at First Baptist Church High Falls in Monroe County. Our most recent clinic was held at First Baptist Church Thomaston where we served over 50 patients. Thank you to all who served our community through this wonderful ministry.

- If you or someone you know is without dental insurance and in need of dental care, call 706-741-4737 for an appointment beginning March 4th at 9:00 AM. This number will not be active until that morning. The person in need of dental care will need to be the one making the appointment, since we have to ask personal medical questions. Please note that no one will be seen without an appointment. Patients will need reliable transportation to FBC High Falls in Jackson, GA TWICE between Thursday and Saturday. These appointments are in high demand and the call volume is high. Please continue to call until you speak with someone. No voicemails will be returned.
- If you are a dentist, dental assistant, or medical professional and would like to serve the community through this ministry, please contact the CBA office and we will put you in touch with our coordinator. It is vital that we have all of our dental and medical professionals scheduled at least two weeks prior to the clinic.
- If you would like to volunteer to serve at the dental clinic in some other capacity, we invite you to attend the Volunteer Training Session which will be held at 4:00 PM the day of screening appointments, March 7th. If you have attended this training before it is not necessary to attend again, but we still need you to contact the CBA office so we can schedule you to help.
