A Word from Your Mission Strategist, Steve Laughman

"For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus." – Philippians 1:6

There are days when life is downright frustrating. Perhaps our perfectly organized plans seem to be falling apart, or we are overwhelmed by the distractions of life. Maybe people in our life aren't acting the way we want, or we just can't get ourselves together. Whatever frustration you are facing, remember that God saved you for a purpose. There will also be a time for individual churches to discuss how the principles we are discussing affect their church. We anticipate a productive time for the churches that take advantage of this workshop.
